# Scholarship Criteria

## ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

1. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior.
2. Provide a copy of high school transcripts.
3. Include a list of high school activities, i.e., clubs, sports, student government, etc.
4. Include a list of extra-curricular activities
5. Submit an essay detailing your career objectives, life goals, and activities that help you meet your objectives.

## VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

Regarding VOCATIONAL AWARDS, the term “vocation” is not confined to the traditional “working with tools”, but remember this covers Trade Schools or Junior College. For example, additionally, some of the occupations would include: Hospital Health Services, Cosmetology, Culinary, Electronic/Computer Repair, Child Care/Education, Travel Agent, Clerical/Office Administration, Trade Work, etc.

The Scholarship Committee will evaluate each vocational application as a package, with different weights given to the items listed. Such as, a direction in high school study, i.e., courses that point to a vocation, work experience in that field, if any, and the intention of attending a school that is oriented toward a vocation. To give applicants some examples, which are very limited and local to the area, are DVC Vocational Programs, e.g., DVC Dental Technology, LMC Police Academy, Laney College Vocational Programs, Heald Business College/Institute of Technology, Aktra Travel College, Anthony Schools (Real Estate, Insurance, Banking, Contractor, etc., Bryan College (court reporter), Construction Craft Training Center (electricians, sheet metal, plumbers, pipefitters, carpenters, Silicone Valley College, etc.

Annually we allot 2 Academic and 2 Vocational scholarships. If applications for vocational scholarship applications are not received, all scholarships will be presented to academic applicants.

**PLEASE NOTE: The committee does NOT consider a 2-year program leading to a General Ed AA degree as vocational.**
